

Official Contest Rules

1. This contest will consist of a competition for the use of a Yamaha Motocross Bike and limited sponsorship for the 2009 race season. This contest begins on March 8, 2008 and ends on October 5, 2008. The contest winner will be decided by the rider with the greatest number of documented top 5 finishes in the 2008 race season at any motocross track the participant competes.
2. Limited Sponsorship. The limited sponsorship includes shop labor at no cost on the motorcycle that the winner is awarded. Parts and accessories will also be included at dealership cost.
3. Eligibility. This contest is open to all motocross racers within 150 miles of Power Sports Unlimited in Columbus, Mississippi. The contest will include all classes and has no age limitations, although, a parent or legal guardian will be responsible for signing the application for their child. There is no limit on the amount of participants in this contest. The cut-off date for entry is April 30, 2008. Late entrants will not be eligible for contest. Lost, late, illegible, incomplete, or misdirected entries are not eligible.
4. How to enter. To enter contest, participants should stop by Power Sports Unlimited at 3500 Bluecutt Rd. Columbus, MS 39705 and complete a Power Sports Unlimited MX Bike and Sponsorship Contest application. The application is also available online at www.bgpsu.com . This is the Power Sports Unlimited official website. All applications, forms, standings and rules will be posted on this site.
5. How to Participate. After participant has been entered into the contest, they will be given a Power Sports Unlimited Graphics Kit. The graphics kit includes 2 Power Sports Unlimited swing arm decals and 2 Power Sports Unlimited Logo decals that can be placed anywhere visible on the bike. The graphics must be displayed on the participants bike at all times until the end of the contest. After each race, the rider must complete a Race Documentation Form that must be signed by a track official. The Race Documentation Form must then be mailed, faxed, or dropped of in person to Power Sports Unlimited within 5 business days of the race. Any forms received after five business days will not be eligible.
6. Estes Motocross Park. This contest will be in cooperation with Estes Motocross Park. There will be three races held at Estes Motocross Park. The dates are March 8, 2008, October 4, 2008, and October 5, 2008. The participants are required to enter into two of the three races held at Estes Motocross Park or they will be eliminated.
7. Disqualification. Participants may be disqualified in several ways that are listed. If the participant does not enter two of the three Estes Motocross Park races, they will be disqualified. Removal of the Power Sports Unlimited graphics kit before the end of the contest will result in disqualification. Any negative publicity will result in disqualification. Cheating in races will result in disqualification. False application information or false information on the race documentation form will result in disqualification.
8. Prize Awarding. All prizes awarded will be awarded according to these official rules. All Prizes must be claimed within 30 days of declaration of contest winner. The winner may be required to attend a winner's ceremony at Power Sports Unlimited. The rider that wins the competition will not be awarded the sponsorship

until all finishes for the season has been verified. The prize is limited to and will be the winner's choice of a Yamaha YZ85, Yamaha YZ125, Yamaha YZ250F, or the Yamaha YZ450F. The motorcycle will remain the property of Power Sports Unlimited, and must be returned to Power Sports Unlimited upon the ending of the 2009 race season.

9. Contest Winner Requirements. The Contest Winner must display Power Sports Unlimited graphics on the motorcycle and trailer for the entire 2009 season. The rider must display a Power Sports Unlimited banner in their pit area at all times they are in attendance at any race, no matter where the track is. The rider must be a good advocate of Power Sports Unlimited. The sponsorship is not automatically renewable each year. The sponsored rider will have to compete as everyone else for the motorcycle the following year.
10. Termination of Sponsorship. Any use of the motorcycle other than racing or practice is prohibited. No one may use the motorcycle other than the certified MX team rider. Failure will result in termination of sponsorship. Negative publicity will result in termination of sponsorship. Not following official contest rules could result in termination of sponsorship. Damage to the motorcycle will be at the expense of the rider. Parts may be purchased at dealership cost. Shop labor will be provided at no charge. After-market modifications will be the expense of the rider. After-market parts will remain the property of the winner. The Factory Yamaha parts will be replaced at the end of the season and the bike will be sold as a demo. The winner will have the first option to purchase the bike.
11. Tie. If there is a tie between participants for the sponsorship, the riders with the greatest number of top finishes will be declared the winner. In the case of a tie, the rider with the most first place finishes will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, the rider with the most second place finishes will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, the rider with the most third place finishes will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, the rider with the most fourth place finishes will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, the rider with the most fifth place finishes will be declared the winner. If a tie remains, then a random drawing will be performed.
12. Limitation of Liability. By entering, entrants agree (a) to these official rules and decisions of Power Sports Unlimited, which shall be binding and final in all respects; (b) release Power Sports Unlimited from all liability, loss, or damage arising out of participation in the contest and with respect to awarding, receipt, possession, use, and/or misuse of any prize; (c) acknowledge that neither Power Sports Unlimited and Yamaha make any warranty, representation, or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, relative to any prize, and disclaim all liability for the provision, quality or nature of any third-party products or services provided to the winner. By participating, the winners release Power Sports Unlimited, their respective officers, directors, employees, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising, promotion, fulfillment, marketing agencies, public relation firms, consultants, or contractors from any and all liability, claims, or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages, or losses to persons (including death) and property that may be sustained in connection with the receipt, ownership, possession, acceptance, enjoyment, use or misuse of a prize, or arising out of participation in the contest, or while preparing for, participating in, and/or traveling to any prize related activity. In no event will Power Sports

Unlimited, their respective officers, directors, employees, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising, promotion, fulfillment, marketing agencies, public relation firms, consultants, or contractors be responsible or liable for any damages or loses of any kind, including without limitation indirect, incidental, consequential, or punitive damages, arising out of any participation in the contest or acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize awarded in connection with this contest, including without limitation, personal injury, death, and/or property damage, as well as any claims based on publicity rights or invasion of privacy.
