The Emerald Track

If you wish to make the Tour of Florida Ride on your own time & be eligible to purchase a patch commemorating your achievement, you will be required to provide documentation of your trip.

The Route is as follows: Start in Port Charlotte. I-75 South across Alligator Alley to the Miami Area, I-95 North to Jacksonville, I-10 West over to I-75 South and I-75 South back to Port Charlotte. You may ride this route in either direction (i.e.: 75N to 10E to 95S to 75N).

This documentation is to take the form of gas station receipts with a location, date & time stamp on them.

Obtain your first receipt here in Port Charlotte before you begin your trip. This will document your starting date and time. You must follow the route as outlined above, but may ride it in either direction. You will be required to show documentation (stamped gas receipts) at each of the four “corners” of the route: Naples area (I-75 at toll road before/after Alligator Alley), Ft. Lauderdale Area (I-75 & I-95), Jacksonville area (I-95 & I-10), Lake City area (I-10 & I-75). Your final receipt will be in Port Charlotte again, documenting the end of your ride.

There is no time limit for this ride, however, the dates and times on the receipts must be in order and close enough together to show that you did this ride all in one stretch with no short-cuts or individual trips direct to each of the documentation corners.

Take your receipts and make copies (you can put them all on the same page if you wish) and then bring them to the dealership to get your patch. Passengers that ride along for the whole trip will also be eligible to buy a patch. Cost of the patch is \$10.
