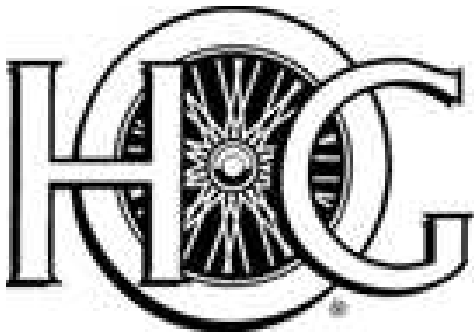
- The first progressive pot winner was Jackie Sondergaard, who won \$127! Just a reminder that you need to be present to win; it pays to come to the meetings!
