

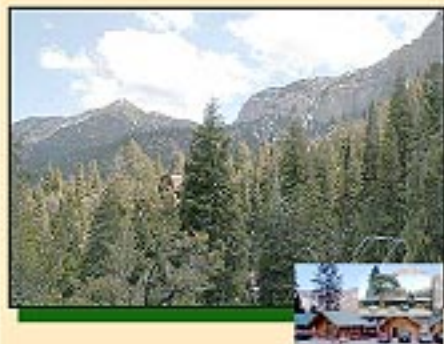

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Mount Charleston & Lee Canyon

The area known as Mount Charleston is made up of the 316,000-acre Spring Mountains National Recreation Area, which is part of the Toiyabe National Forest.

On the average, Mount Charleston is always average 30 degrees cooler than Las Vegas, this occurs because the Mount Charleston area is the highest elevation in Nevada. Summer months are great, but for winter enthusiasts skiing is available within a 45-minute drive from the Las Vegas Strip at Lee Canyon.

Mount Charleston/Toiyabe National Forest is only 40-miles north of Las Vegas on route 95.

- Depart 1010 W Warm Springs Rd
- Turn **LEFT (North)** onto N Gibson Rd
- Turn **LEFT (West)** onto W Sunset Rd, then immediately bear **RIGHT (North-West)** onto Ramp
- Merge onto I-515 [US-93] Road name changes to US-95
- At exit 77, keep **RIGHT** onto Rancho Drive / US-95 BUSINESS
- Take Ramp (**RIGHT**) onto US-95 Bus [SR-599]
- Bear **LEFT (West)** onto W Craig Rd
- Take Ramp (**RIGHT**) onto US-95
- Turn **LEFT (West)** onto SR-157
- Turn **RIGHT (North-East)** onto Mt Charleston
- Arrive Mount Charleston



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
