Grand Canyon

Grand Canyon National Game Preserve (established in 1906), became Grand Canyon National Park by an Act of Congress in 1919.

Grand Canyon National Park covers 1,218,375 acres in northwestern Arizona. It includes 105 miles of the most colorful part of the Grand Canyon of the Colorado River.

Grand Canyon is known for its overwhelming size and its intricate and colorful landscape. Geologically it is significant because of the thick sequence of ancient rocks that are beautifully preserved and exposed in the walls of the canyon.

Depart 1010 W Warm Springs Rd, Henderson, NV Rd (East)

Turn LEFT (North) onto N Gibson Rd

Turn LEFT (West) onto W Sunset Rd, then immediately bear RIGHT (North-West) onto Ramp

Merge onto I-515 [US-93] I-15 | US-93 | Salt Lake City

At exit 16, turn RIGHT onto Ramp

Turn RIGHT (South-East) onto SR-9 [W State St]

Turn RIGHT (East) onto SR-59

Entering Arizona

Road name changes to Grand Canyon National Park

Arrive Grand Canyon National Park
