Valley of Fire

Dedicated in 1935, Valley of Fire is Nevada's oldest State Park. It is located only 50 miles northeast of Las Vegas. The rough floor and jagged walls of the park contain brilliant formations of eroded sandstone and sand dunes more than 150 million years old. These features, which are the centerpiece of the park's attractions, often appear to be on fire when reflecting the sun's rays.

Location: Valley of Fire State Park is located in the Mojave Desert of southern Nevada about 50 miles northeast of Las Vegas. It abuts Lake Mead National Recreation Area at the Virgin River confluence. It lies in a basin 4 miles wide by 6 miles long, 15 miles southwest of Overton, Nevada. Its elevation varies between 2,000 and 2,600 feet.

Entrance Fee: \$5.00 per vehicle per day; \$35.00 for annual pass.

Seasons/Hours: Open year round, dawn to dusk.

Depart Henderson Harley-Davidson

Turn LEFT (North) onto N Gibson Rd

Turn LEFT (West) onto W Sunset Rd, immediately bear RIGHT (North-West) I-515 [US-93]

At exit 76D, take Ramp (RIGHT) onto I-15 [US-93] Salt Lake City

At exit 93, take Ramp (RIGHT) onto SR-12 [SR-169]

Keep RIGHT onto Valley of Fire State Park
