

# Lewis Boats Marine Sales & Service - Crappie Tournament

Mark Twain Lake - Saturday, March 27, 2010

**Entry Fee Deadline – 5:30 p.m. – March 25, 2010**

Take-off: 7:00 a.m. – Anywhere on Mark Twain Lake

Weigh-in: 2:30 p.m. – Hwy 107 Boat Ramp

## OFFICIAL RULES and ENTRY FORM

**RULES:** These rules will be interpreted solely by the Tournament Committee and all decisions are final.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$70 Per Boat. Up to 3 Persons Per Boat.

1. Team Tournament. Teams will consist of a maximum of 3 persons. All team members must be in the same boat.
2. Teams may take off at any ramp on Mark Twain Lake
3. A team cannot weigh-in more than 10 crappie and those must be alive when entering the Official Weigh-In Site line. Any team presenting more than 10 crappie will be disqualified. Once you have entered the weigh-in line, your fish will be counted and verified dead or alive. Dead fish will be removed and you may continue to the scales for your official weigh-in. Once your fish have been verified alive and entered on the weigh-in voucher, you will then be allowed to weigh-in those fish, even if one or more die before reaching the scales. The tournament committee has sole responsibility for the declaration of dead or alive crappie.
4. Fish weighed must be a minimum of 9 inches long. Official measure will be the grip and check.
5. Live and artificial baits may be used.
6. Fish must be caught on a pole and line. **NO SNAGGING or POOLING OF FISH BETWEEN TEAMS.** 1 pole per man. No more than 2 hooks per pole.
7. Teams may start fishing (line in water) anywhere on Mark Twain Lake at 7:00 a.m. You must stop fishing at 1:30 p.m. and be in the weigh-in line by 2:30 p.m.
8. All team members must be present at time of weigh-in.
9. No team will be allowed to join weigh-in line after 2:30 p.m.
10. Only one big fish entry per team. Team must designate big fish entry at time of weigh-in. Big fish pot will be paid as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Place – 70% and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 30% of total Big Fish Pot.
11. All State Boating and Fishing Regulation Must Be Followed.
12. Fishing and boating license and launching fees are the responsibility of each angler.
13. A team may be disqualified if, in the opinion of the tournament committee, a team member or members are intoxicated.
14. In the event of a tie, Big Fish will determine the winner.
15. No one can be hired or compensated in any way to fish with you or mark your spots for you prior to the tournament at any time.
16. Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation are expected from each tournament contestant. There will be no fishing within 50 feet of any boat unless you have permission from that boat or water conditions void this rule. Tournament waters are off limits on the day prior to the tournament at 12:00 midnight.

### PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE and ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK

1. **I have read and understand the description of the tournament and the OFFICIAL RULES of this tournament.** I will obey all rules and understand that any violation may result in immediate disqualification without refund of my entry fee. I also understand that tournament officials may reject my application for any reason, and in that event Lewis Boats Marine Sales & Service will refund my entry fee.
2. I understand and acknowledge that competitive fishing is a dangerous sport, the risks of which include but not limited to, risk of injury or death or damage to my property or myself or to others, including spectators and their property, arising from my participation in the tournament.
3. I hereby release, discharge and agree to hold harmless, defend and indemnify Lewis Boats Marine Sales & Service, contestants, sponsors, tournament officials and their agents. I acknowledge and agree that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged while I am engaged in this event, I will have no right to make a claim or file a lawsuit against Lewis Boats Marine Sales & Service, sponsors, tournament officials and their agents.
4. I have sufficient health, accident and liability insurance to cover any bodily injury or property damage incurred by myself or others as a result of my participation in this event. If I have no such insurance, I represent that I am capable of paying for any and all such expenses or liability.
5. I give Lewis Boats Marine Sales & Service permission to use my name, likeness and photograph for promotional purposes.
