**What's New? by CEO Don Finkle:** I'm writing this on

Sunday because the spring busy season has already arrived. There is a lot going on around here at RCR, both in sales and in the boat yards.

Hopefully I'll get caught up so I can go home and watch the Olympics, which we've found to be very interesting. Well most of the events have been interesting, there are a few I scratch my head about. One of the guys who works for us in the Buffalo service department, Adam DePeters, will be off this week so he can go to Vancouver to watch his brother Matt ski. Matt is a member of the US Olympic Ski Team and will be competing in the Freestyle Aerials. Go Matt!

With the start of the boating season not far off, it is time to remind everyone to make your plans, both for your time off as well as for any boating needs. I learned a few years back that if I did a better job of planning my summer schedule in the off season, I ended up with more time on the water. We are all caught in the whirlwind of modern society, with too much to do and too little time to do it all. It's a matter of priority. Make boating a priority when you plan and you are much more likely to get to go on that cruise this July.

As for your boating needs, we have two cautionary comments for you. First, the economic downturn of the past two years has resulted in a lot of attrition in the supply chain for boat parts. Now the worm is starting to turn, people are coming back to buy again, which will cause some shortages. You may find that you will have to order a part instead of finding it on the shelf. So don't wait until May 15 to go shopping for that new fishfinder. The same goes for having service work done, your yard is unlikely to have extra staff kicking around, so give them your work orders now so they will be able to fit you into the schedule.

Those shopping for a boat right now can still take advantage of the weakness that has brought prices to very attractive levels. You will note a number of price reductions in the list of boats for sale below. However, the surplus of boats on the market is not what it was a year ago. Gradually boat sales have begun to take place faster than boats are

coming onto the market, which is the opposite of what was happening before. This is a good thing for the health of the industry and for boat owners who have seen the value of their boats decline. So now is the time to shop while supply and prices are still in the buyer's favor.

**Some weeks back we went to the grocery store in NYC** with our son, hoping to pick up some ingredients for a nice home cooked meal at his apartment. The Whole Foods store was packed with people and the produce department was seriously picked-over, not much left and what was there didn't look so good. That reminded me of what happens to boat buyers who wait until May to shop. Just which boats do you think sell first? Of course, the nicest ones and the ones that are priced right. So what is left by May? You get the picture. Don't wait.

**Sometimes we don't get it.** Despite all of our years of professional experience and product knowledge, coupled with on-water experience, once in awhile we have a hard time figuring out why a certain boat hasn't sold when it should have. We've sold lots of boats, yet here is one of the best and its still here. Sometimes people will buy lesser vessels when the one that is better built, performs better and is more functional and user-friendly is still available, despite being priced right. Maybe it is because we know the attributes of the boat better than the buyers do, and they overlook important aspects of the boat and its features because they are unaware of what it can do. So we'll tell you:

A prime example would be the Back Cove 29 "Kilbride" that we currently have for sale. I am really embarrassed that we have not sold this boat yet, it is cleaner and better priced than others on the market. The Back Cove styling is gorgeous, you can't pull into a harbor without people taking notice of the beautiful classic lines. It is built like a tank, is powered by a durable and fuel-efficient diesel engine, and reeks of quality inside and out. It'll blast through a sea when others are slowed to hobby-horsing nausea, and the helm deck, cockpit, side decks and foredeck are all actually usable. Here is a boat that you can really go somewhere in. Sure you can sit at the dock if you want, but you can also go cruising in safety and comfort. Check it out, inside our heated showroom in Youngstown. It is the kind of boat I'd be proud to own myself. Some smart buyer is going to get a great deal on a great boat. Its not like Back Coves in general are not selling, the field inventory of new and used is small.

**Raymarine News:** This brand has been the most common make of electronics in use in recent years. You should be aware of major changes being made to their line of equipment. Time marches on and in the electronics world technology is always advancing. New Digital equipment is replacing analog. Those who currently have Raymarine gear on their boat should be aware that there is a very brief window now for adding equipment that is compatible with what you already have. This is especially true with Radar. If you have a C Series plotter it will NOT function with the new digital radar. So if you want to add radar you need to locate an analog radar antenna before they are all gone, and they are in short supply. Otherwise you will need to replace your existing plotter. WEST Marine and your local ship's store should be able to explain further, as can we. The new High-Definition Digital radar is very slick.

**Marine groups write to EPA about E15:** In response to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's pending decision on the Growth Energy waiver petition on E15, the National Marine Manufacturers Association, BoatUS and a number of other organizations sent a letter to administration officials urging them to base their decision on sound, scientific data.

"We are writing to express our concern that EPA may allow E15 based on limited or inadequate data, as implied in its Nov. 30 letter to Growth Energy," the groups wrote to EPA administrator Lisa Jackson; Department of Energy secretary Steven Chu; and director of the White House Office of Energy and Climate Change Policy Carol Browner.

"We urge EPA to base its decision on a complete and sound scientific record, and we urge DOE to help provide this science by spending all of the \$15 million targeted for expanding and accelerating mid-level ethanol blends research in the 2010 appropriations bill ...," the letter states.

As a First Mate aboard your boat, just how familiar are you with its operation? What if the Skipper should become disabled? Would you know what to do? Would you know how to call for help? Would you be able to tell rescuers where you are? Would you be able to navigate to a safe port?

The First Mate Safe Return course is designed to teach fundamental skills that will enable a First Mate to do the right thing if the Skipper should become disabled for whatever reason.
