**What's New? by CEO Don Finkle:** March is the last month for us to prepare for the annual spring rush. Once April 1st comes around we go into full-tilt mode. We never really got a break this winter, there has been a lot of work to do, both on customers' boats as well as facility maintenance and improvement. This week two of our electronics techs, Andy Lopez and Brian Buczak, will be in Toronto taking NMEA classes. We have been doing more and more installations of electronics and mechanical systems and upgrades.

Do you have Raymarine electronics on your boat? If so, and you have been considering adding Radar, you have a choice to make, but only if you act soon. Analog radar is being phased out in favor of Digital Radar. If you have Raymarine chartplotters that are pre-Widescreen series they will not work with the new Digital Radar. So you need to either locate one of the remaining Analog Radars, which are no longer being made, or update to a new Widescreen plotter. WEST Marine had a run of Analog Radars made to accommodate those who wish to add radar without changing the rest of their systems.

That being said, the new Digital Radar is really nice, and the Hi-Definition Digital Radar is even better.

Sales have begun to turn the corner. Our industry suffered through two of the worst years in memory but now the tune has changed. We survived 2008 & 2009 by selling mostly small used boats, waiting for the new boat market to come back, as well as more expensive brokerage boats. In the last couple of months we have seen a significant improvement in terms of both customer interest and deals being written. We are selling new boats again and the brokerage market as a whole has picked up across the price spectrum. It is still tough but getting better.

Rick Lenard told me yesterday that he had heard from both of the customers he sold boats to in Florida this winter. Each is happily enjoying their new babies and were pleased with what Rick and RCR did for them. When these folks from salt water came

to see how nice our fresh water boats were they promptly snapped them up, and are very glad they did. It is bittersweet for us, nice to make the sale but tough to see the boat leave the area.

**March 20, First Mate Safe Return® Course:** A boating safety course offered exclusively by the Sodus Bay Maritime Captains Association.

As a First Mate aboard your boat, just how familiar are you with its operation? What if the Skipper should become disabled? Would you know what to do? Would you know how to call for help? Would you be able to tell rescuers where you are? Would you be able to navigate to a safe port?

The First Mate Safe Return course is designed to teach fundamental skills that will enable a First Mate to do the right thing if the Skipper should become disabled for whatever reason. The course will be taught by Coast Guard Licensed Captains and will include a half-day classroom lecture and on-the-water coaching and demonstration on your own boat. The schedule for the half-day classroom lecture is:
