**What's New? by CEO Don Finkle:** While there is still plenty of boating season left, now is the time to begin to prepare for your fall haul-out and winter storage. RCR offers a full range of maintenance services at our yards in Buffalo and Youngstown, NY. Recently we visited Put-in-Bay, Ohio, a place we had always heard about but never had the opportunity to see until now. PIB is located on South Bass Island in the western basin of Lake Erie, 3 miles from mainland Ohio off Catawba Island (Catawba is really a peninsula, not an Island). There are a series of Limestone islands between the US and Canadian shorelines that vary in size from quite small to the largest, Pelee Island, which is on the Ontario side of the lake. I had seen charts of the area before but never really grasped how close together they all were, it is quite an interesting area to visit and a fine cruising ground. Easy to get to for sure. If you come without your boat there is a ferry that carries vehicles, bicycles, scooters and passengers for a reasonable cost on a frequent schedule, every half-hour.

PIB itself has a sizable harbor that offers dockage, mooring and anchorage areas, with good protection from weather. The village is right on the harbor and can only be described as a summer resort party town. There are restaurants and bars, shops and a yacht club, hotels, B&B's and services for visiting yachts. Swim-up bars at local pools are popular. The first night there we had a Walleye and Perch dinner on the pier and it was delicious. The place really comes alive at night with some serious party action in town and on the boats. You aren't permitted to walk in public with an open container of alcohol, but there sure is a lot of boozing going on in the bars and on the boats. People watching is never boring here. There really is no other place like it in the region that we have seen. If you are looking for a different place to cruise to, give PIB and the nearby islands a try. I would say that 80% of the boats there were powerboats of all sizes and description, from runabouts to million-dollar-plus yachts.

We are approaching the time of year when new models are introduced at the fall shows. This year we are anxious for the public to see the newest Back Cove model, the all-new Back Cove 30. The BC 30 replaces the most popular and longest-tenured model in the line, the renowned Back Cove 29, the boat that started it all. Back Coves are carefully built in Maine, and share the same design philosophy: a modern but sturdy downeast style hull and deck with efficient and economical single engine diesel power. A standard bow thruster, and optional stern thruster, allows easy close-quarters maneuvering even with the single screw. What is surprising to most is that a Back Cove yacht compares favorably price-wise with brands that do not stand up to a close

comparison of features and construction. The new 30 takes the strengths of the 29 and adds all that has been learned over the past 6 years to make an even more comfortable and enjoyable vessel. Probably the major change that you will notice is the seating upgrades that have been integrated into the BC 30 design. There is more and better seating below, on the helm deck, and in the cockpit. The extra size designed into the BC 30 hull provides for much more spaciousness than one would expect of a boat only one foot longer... but wider. Stay tuned for more info.

The other day I took a short ride with a friend on his 17' Mako center console. It was equipped with a 70HP 4 stroke outboard. I noticed two things immediately that differed from my own 17' Aquasport CC with a 70HP 2 stroke OB. Keep in mind that both of our boats are over 30 years old and pretty heavy. The 4 stroke engine was so much quieter at all speeds that it was amazing to me. We have smaller 4 stroke motors on our workboats, and I am used to the lower decibel level, but for an engine this size it was remarkably quiet. The other thing I noted was that the 4 stroke engine does not get the boat up "out of the hole" onto a plane nearly as fast as my 2 stroke motor does. Naturally the 4 stroke is much less fuel-hungry. All considered I would definitely go for a 4 stroke when I repower my own boat, the trade-offs are worth it.

The September issue of MotorBoating magazine has an excellent article on propulsion systems...shaft versus pod drives, single versus twin screw, etc. Interestingly they use Sabre and Back Cove models as the primary boats in their comparisons. You need to read the article to understand all the variables and conclusions, which as you might expect are really trade-offs. As they say, "Ultimately there is no silver bullet. Each propulsion system carries its pros and cons in fuel economy and cruising speed, and each influences other variables, such as interior space and close-quarters handling." In general though, it is safe to say that the single screw application costs less to buy, maintain, and operate. If done right the top end speed is also very close between the single and twin engine installations. However, this applies to cruising boats, not high-speed high-performance craft.

Luxury and comfort is evident on every deck. Great entertainment areas, abundant light both natural and artificial, rich hand-rubbed teak joinery, teak parquet flooring, wonderful furnishings, fabrics and accessories make this vessel truly a home away from home.

**Accommodations**

Entering from either side deck through beautiful teak doors you will immediately notice the spaciousness and Panoramic view from the aft deck salon. Beautifully furnished it makes a wonderful entertainment area, featuring a flat screen TV/DVD and bar. There is a stairway forward and to starboard that will lead you to the bridge deck, also with great visibility and ample seating and storage.

The lower helm station is on the same level as the aft deck salon and separated by the entertainment console and cabinet. The port side of the cabinet has a built-in fridge with icemaker. The mates and captains

bench seat is wide and comfortable. The skipper will enjoy great visibility from the helm and everything is conveniently within reach and view. Electronics include Radar, Color Chartplotter with GPS, Autopilot and a full array of gauges. There is even an intercom.

Moving from the port side forward and down a few steps one enters the spacious main salon. Entertainment and a wonderful seating area will great your guests. Bright open space and a wall full of mirrors make this a cheery space. Forward to port is comfortable L-shaped dinette with a custom teak table. The efficient galley is down to starboard and features lots of cabinet and drawer storage, abundant counter space for even the gourmet and a 3 burner electric range with oven, Dishwasher, S/S sink, Full size side by side refrigerator/freezer, coffeemaker and Microwave.

Forward and down is the forward berth. Not a V-berth but featuring 2 wide bunks one above the other offset. Ample storage, lots of light and beautiful joinery grace this space. Angled to port is the guest head. Privacy, light surfaces, vanity with large mirror, plenty of storage and a separate shower will make your guest feel welcome.

Moving aft again through the main salon we descend toward the owner's stateroom. Another enclosed head with vanity is at the base of the steps to port. Across the way is a large storage closet with beautiful teak louvered doors. As you enter the owner's stateroom you will be treated to soft lighting, beautiful cabinetry full of drawers, shelves and even a dressing table for the lady. A luxurious queen sized bed, is framed by windows looking out her transom. Draperies are drawn for privacy. Wall-mounted lamps with swivel arms for late night reading provide an atmosphere of quiet comfort. Each side, port and starboard is loaded with cabinet and closet space in rich hand-rubbed teak. On the port side a door opens to a walk-in closet.

Another flat-screen TV sits above the dressing area. Angled to starboard is the owner's private head featuring vanity, large mirrors, storage and a tub & shower unit.

#### On Deck

Forward just aft of the high pulpit is an Electric Windlass. After a large open foredeck area is a wonderful padded bench facing forward. It is covered by snap on canvas when not in use. You'll notice wide side decks with high S/S rails for safety all the way back to the doors on the side decks that open to the aft salon. The deck top is very large and flat and would provide a great sun pad area. Forward are twin fender holders on each side. Fenders are covered for chafe protection. The bridge deck has great visibility and ample seating and storage. The upper helm has a "command position." Through the aft salon to starboard is a wide door that give access to a ladder that descends to the swim platform.
