## Commentary:

**My East Coast Tour, by Don Finkle:** "I managed to fit a lot into my trip last weekend, planned around the annual J/boats dealer meeting in Bristol, RI. We met at the factory where the J/95 and new J/111 are being built. This is a beautiful new facility where they also build a variety of other FRP products, including the North Coast and Albin powerboats, hulls and decks for the Hunt powerboats that are finished nearby, and bodies for classic Cobra sportscar replicas. One of the more interesting products they build are fiberglass barges with bathrooms on top, these are hard to describe but actually very nice. I've been around boat factories for almost 40 years, and the mold and glass work being done here is some of the most impressive I've seen.

The J meeting covered a variety of topics but the highlight was the design and construction presentation for the new J/111. We were able to see the hull mold and the deck plug, and actually climb around on the latter. This is going to be one very nice ride. Ben Hall of Hall Spars stopped by to tell us about the rig for the 111, including a special new carbon composite being used on the mast. Next week we will report in more detail. First boat is scheduled to be sailing in June.

Before the J meeting I managed to visit the nearby Hall Spars plant, what an amazing facility that is. Ben and Nan Hall gave me a super tour, I love their products and when you see how they are built you will understand why the quality is so superior. After the J meeting I stopped to see my friend Randy "Dunes" Borges at his Waterline Systems shop. The building was full and he has lots going on, including building three new J/105s. Next up for Dunes is finishing a run of J/80's. On Monday we wrapped up our trip with a visit to Sabre Yachts in Maine. A keel was being installed on a new Sabre Spirit while we were there, that boat is headed to Toledo.

Next week I'll go into more depth on the details of each plant on the tour."

**Miami Grand Prix Melges 32 Regatta Recap, by Adam Burns:** "The final Melges 32 regatta of the winter was held two weeks ago in Miami and proved to be epic. The three fleets in the event consisted of IRC, Farr 40's and the Melges 32's. The biggest fleet was the Melges 32 division with 24 boats. In addition, this regatta for the 32's proved to be the most competitive of the three winter series regattas. This 32 regatta was different as literally every boat was sporting world-class talent. A few familiar names include: Andrew Campbell, Ed Baird (Alinghi's skipper from the America's Cup and first M32 event), Jud Smith, Richard Clarke who was the winning Melges 24 Worlds tactician for Chris Larson; and Laser Gold medalist Paul Goodison, tactician on Joe Wood's "Red" to name a few. For this regatta we had a new face on board "Star", Jeff Madrigali from North Sails. Jeff's accomplishments in the sport of sailing are as impressive as anyone's. One of Jeff's comments summed up the few days of racing: "These were tough conditions. If you got back in the pack, it was really tough to find a fast lane, there's only so much space. So, a lot of times you knew where to go, but then there's someone in your way, so then you have to deal with the bad air or find another way."

Every start line and mark rounding was a full-on battleground and a combination of inch perfect steering by the skippers. The slickest of boat-handling and the sharpest possible tactical calls were required to get anywhere near the top tier. Drop the ball in any of these departments and you would have been immediately and unceremoniously dispatched to the back of the fleet. Beyond sailing skills, success in this fleet is, as much as anything, about mental fortitude. The ability to reset and pick yourselves up after a deep result is paramount. A glance at the score sheet illustrates this point perfectly; with all of the overall top five boats having to count double-digit finishes. With three different winners from the last three major regattas, the Melges 32 class is becoming increasingly difficult to predict and even harder to achieve success in. A great job by the French Team who won this regatta after a disappointing Key West where they finished 13th. At the end of the regatta it was impressive to see that the point spread between 2nd and 5th place was only three points after ten races!!"
