Commentary:

Q Factor and PHRF Racing on Lake Ontario, by Bob Porter, Asst Chief Handicapper: "As I reported at the beginning of last season, PHRF Lake Ontario changed its Q Factor in the formula that produces handicap multipliers from your time on time numbers. The Q Factor is a number that determines handicaps between and among boats. Increasing the Q Factor increases the difference between boats, lowering it reduces the difference. The 2009 adjustment expanded the handicap range by approximately 14.8%. In other words, if the handicap between you and another boat was 100 seconds per mile, it became, effectively, 114.8 seconds.

The change was designed to bring sailboat racing closer to equity. It has long been recognized that the PHRF system favors the larger, lower handicap number, yachts. This adjustment brought the handicap halfway to complete equity. (PHRF-LO determined the pre-2009 difference between handicaps was actually 30%). It is also known that most racing occurs during the evenings and the winds often die as the evening advances. This might account for some of the handicap prejudice.

The 2009 change in handicap resulted in closer racing and fewer PHRF class boat reviews by the PHRF-LO Central Council. It also resulted in fewer handicap changes for the 2010 sailing season. No change in the handicapping system is planned through 2010 though the Central Council is shifting the mean boat value. In the past the mean boat was at 177 seconds per mile. It is believed that that number is now closer to 169. The effect of changing the mean boat number to around 169 is likely to be very small.

Lake Erie & LYRA Boat of the Year, by Bob Porter: "Lake Yacht Racing Association (LYRA) represents clubs on Lake Ontario, nearby waters, **and the eastern end of Lake Erie.** The 2010 LYRA Annual Regatta will be held at Buffalo YC and on Lake Erie waters. This is only the second time in the 126 year history of LYRA that the regatta has been held on other than Lake Ontario. For the 2010 sailing season LYRA will adjust the Boat of the Year events to reflect the venue change of the annual regatta.

Events are being added to the LYRA BOTY event qualifier list to ensure that boats from Lake Erie (and those that travel to lake Ontario for the regatta) have a reasonable chance to compete for LYRA boat of the

Year. All the current events, including the Lake Erie Interclub Cruise, Mayor's & Queens Cup (Buffalo), and Sugarloaf Regatta remain qualifiers. Additionally LYRA will add other major distance races and regattas on Lake Erie to include the following:

- Cleveland race Week
- Lake Erie International
- Sandusky Hospice Regatta
- Mills Trophy Race (Tier 1)
- Mentor Race
- Put-in-Bay Race Week (tier 1)
- Trans Erie Race (Tier 1)
- Falcon Cup

To qualify for Boat of the Year a boat must sail the LYRA Annual Regatta course races, at least 2 other Tier 1 qualifiers, and four others for the list of qualifying events. The eventual winner is determined at the end of the season by the yacht's performance in the events they sailed. A Good Letter from Scuttlebutt: From Bruce Ells: (re, 'What's Really Wrong With Yacht Clubs' in #3078) "Unfortunately for many yacht clubs, and for their members who pay the bills, there are lots of sailing crew who won't step up and join the club where they do their sailing on other people's boats, because they feel it's just not worth it when they don't own a boat or go to the club on any day other than race day. These people are reaping huge benefits and lifetime experiences in the enjoyment they get from sailboat racing, but they want other people to pay for it.

I understand it costs money to support a family and put children through college, and those are priorities over sailboat racing, but it also costs money to establish and maintain a yacht club. And it takes dedicated volunteers to run the yacht club and all its events and races. The only volunteers I've ever seen at the club and at the races are our dues-paying yacht club members. Along with not joining the club, and thereby helping with the cost of providing all the enjoyment non-member crew seem to want to have, many don't want to volunteer either.

The yacht club members I know happily pay for their own fun, and they pay for a lot of other people's fun, too. We can help grow membership by encouraging our non-member crews to be a real part of what it takes to have a race day."

Minimum age of 20 years

* Applicants are required to have attended the Fundamental Course either as a full participant (candidate), observer or assistant and be familiar with the material and contents of the course.
