What's New? By Don Finkle: This my 39th year at RCR and we've seen and experienced a lot during that time. Clearly the last two years have been the most difficult due to the economic mess we had to deal with, which hit our entire industry very hard. Fortunately things have turned around for us and we are enjoying a much better year. Boats have been selling again and service work has been strong. We are now in the position of growing once more, although in a controlled and measured way. As a result we are looking to hire a few talented people to join our team. Specifically we are looking for a couple of people to add to the RCR Buffalo operation. We need an administrative assistant to work with our very capable marina manager Darren Wright, and a mechanic. We use the term mechanic loosely, as we can actually use anyone with technical skills in diesel engine, electronic, and/or mechanical systems. We are getting into the meat of the new sailing season and so there is much to write about. In this issue we have results and reports for the Hospice Nationals, Detroit NOOD, Susan Hood Race, BHSC Icebreaker, and the LOSHRS Queen City Race. Before we get into that we would just like to make a few random comments:

We much prefer it when race officers talk to the fleet over the VHF so that everyone knows what they are thinking. It makes it more enjoyable for the participants, and helps those with less experience understand what is going on and why. Maybe we don't need this for the Olympics or a World Championship, but for most racing, especially with multiple fleets, it is the way to go.

We wrote before about the responsibility of the crew and how often sailors don't treat their skippers/owners with the respect that they deserve. My main beef is the no-show,

or the last minute cancellation. This seems to happen more when it is rainy or cold. The classic one is the 2 PM call for the 6 PM start with "I can't make it tonight, it is my wife's birthday". So you didn't know it was your wife's birthday last week when we would have adequate time to find someone to replace you? My own crew is very good about this, but we see it way too often. It leads owners to give up racing, and that is a very bad thing. Buy some foul weather gear and suck it up! Sailing is not always about 78 degrees and sun.

OK, I'm on a roll here. While we are talking about respect, how about some for those who do all the work so you can just show up and race? We are referring to waiting until the 11th hour to register for a regatta. This makes it difficult for the organizers and is totally unnecessary. With on-line registration now being the norm it is easier than ever. PLEASE sign up now for the regattas you plan to do.

This week the Buffalo YC hosts the Ira Ross Great Race match racing series. The racing takes place in the harbor in front of Erie Basin Marina so spectating is readily available. Good luck to BYC, they put a ton of effort into this event.

Susan Hood overnight race run from PCYC, by Brian Townsend: "Please find enclosed the results from this past weekends Susan Hood Trophy Race.

The course was PCYC - Burlington Weather Mark, Niagara Falls R2 and return to PCYC. The Susan Hood Trophy is awarded to the overall winner based on best corrected time in PHRF after the IRC divisions are converted to PHRF.

The 2010 winner is Lively, J109 from ABYC who beat out MacIntosh by 9 seconds.

The race was another classic Susan Hood that offered a little of everything except the traditional freeze at 2AM. The first leg varied from a close to a beam reach under an amazing lightning show from the surrounding storms. There was some healthy rain along this run and at times very heavy rain. By the time the majority of the fleet reached Burlington weather mark the wind was gone as a result of the storm front moving south. Some boats were becalmed for well over 1 hour. The wind did pick from the north west and provided an excellent spinnaker run down to Niagara under a star filled sky. From Niagara Mark back to PCYC was a close reach with winds gusting up to 25 knots which tapered off in the afternoon.

This years Line Honours was claimed by Gaucho, a Farr 44 from the Buffalo Canoe Club with a time of 11:09:40.

There were 77 boats competing this year, which is a huge increase from the 50 boat average over the last 3 years. Of special note was the very high level of competition in both IRC and PHRF 1. There were also a higher than normal number of first time competitors, which is always a great sign of things to come.

As the warm up race to the Lake Ontario 300, this year's Susan Hood is a strong indication that the LO300 on July 18th is shaping up to be a very exciting event. With over 125 yachts registered the LO300 is on pace to break another participation record. www.lo300.org

The awards banquet for this year's Susan Hood Trophy Race will be held in conjunction with the LO300 Awards night at the end of September. Although a few boats pulled out of this year's race everyone arrive home and in a totally unusual year there were no reports of frostbite out there. The first race of the 2010 season turned out to be a great success."

Detroit NOOD, by Don Finkle: "Regular readers of the RCR Racers News will recall that I have always been very complimentary of the Bayview YC in Detroit. We have made many friends there, they run great regattas, and we've always been treated well. What was a well-run and otherwise fun event, as usual, was marred by a tragic accident this year. The accident had nothing to do with boats or sailing, it occurred on the dock after Saturday's racing when one of our friends from the Beneteau 36.7 class, Chuck Bayer, was hosting his informal blender party on the dock. A vehicle operated by one of the volunteers jumped the curb and landed in the midst of the group gathered on the dock. It was a freak accident, the result of which was one fatality, various other injuries, and our friend Chuck seriously injured and in hospital.

Chuck and his crew aboard Grizzly were winning the event after two days, but obviously did not sail on Sunday after the previous night's accident, despite the fact that Chuck begged the crew from his hospital bed to take the boat and finish the regatta. The Class unaimously agreed to award them average points for the remaining races, so Grizzly earned the well deserved win in a 12 boat fleet. The shock of the entire episode has yet to wear off, and we feel for our friends at Bayview. This was a freak accident that is a reminder to all of just how fleeting life can be at times.

Under the circumstances it is hard to write much about the racing itself, other than to say our fleet had many position changes and good racing on the water. Maybe next week I'll feel more like reporting on the sailing."

LOSHRS QCYC Course Race Report: "Despite the day's weather prospects and lack of depth at Queen City, 54 boats challenged the elements for the 2010 LOSHRS opening race. Thank you for coming out. I know everyone had a great time, because at LOSHRS - "Everyone's a Winner".

Twenty seven skippers, (half the fleet) attended the Queen City pre-race meeting and picked up the SI's, copies of GAM, previewed the new 2010 regalia and helped Diane by purchasing some raffle tickets. Gary Benner rode his bike from RCYC just to attend the skippers meeting - thank you for your support. Gary could not take part in our first race, but in the Susan Hood his new Shock 40 was the 2nd boat to finish - Congratulations Gary!

The QCYC Course Race Overall Best Corrected time goes to Black Magic. Yes Al Hansen does it again; 2 years ago at the Dalhousie weekend race he won overall as well. Congratulations Al!

 2nd Overall - Seajay, Jim Johnstone's corrected time was 2:43:15

3rd Overall - Daybreak, John Skinner's corrected time was 2:48:03
 4th Overall - Timorian, Fred Harding's corrected time was 2:48:14
 5th Overall - Ascend, Nick Mather's corrected time was 2:49:49

(How about the Reliance 12m, not only was Nick 5th overall, he won his division too!) Congratulations to you all.....And Jaegar, Cory Sawchuck won his division in D-H NFS with a corrected time of 2:50:44 - Way to go Cory!"

LOSHRS Update: A very special mention to our single-handed hero's who have qualified for GLSS: John Ball aboard Anne Bonny finished 2nd in division and was the first 2010 qualifier. He is a 30 year veteran in one-design, LOSHRS & the LO300. Gene Jolson, aboard Joely Rose was 3rd in his division in his fast & well-named Catalina 36 . Brian Mitchell aboard Different Drummer 1 has qualified with his C&C 27. Brent Hughes aboard Pearl, a C&C 35 is now all fixed up & ready to go. Note that 4 of the 9 signed up to complete in the GLSS division of the LO300 sail in LOSHRS.....Good luck to you all!

Lesson learned:

Rounding the Lake Mark this year was hairy indeed with many competitors in single & double-handed white and double-handed spinnaker all caught up with each other at the mark, causing numerous close encounters of the wrong kind.

Unfortunately the slower boats who started first met the larger boats at the lake mark at the same time!

At LOSHRS, our mandate is Safety First, followed by good wholesome fun. It is for that reason that we will review the race, and consider changes to alleviate possible congestion on the course. We will keep you posted.

LOSHRS Youngstown 2-day event: Ric Doedens is arranging Homeland Security to meet us at YYC, more info will follow. For those that have not done the race before, this process makes it a lot more convenient to enter the US for this race.

Jan & Maggie Steyn, who race the LOSHRS series from YYC will host a dock gathering upon finishing. We thank you for your hospitality.
