Last Week's IRC Bulletin: "We are on to our second event in the Lake Ontario Championship Series this weekend with the RCYC Open Regatta. Our first event in the series was a resounding success with ABYC doing its usual outstanding job of hosting the first LORC Open Regatta event of the year.

The move to three divisions for our IRC fleet has been met with very positive feedback from all competitors and we feel we now have the right boats sailing together to create some outstanding racing within the divisions. We did do a little last minute shuffling to ensure this and we are very pleased with the results so far. Please be aware that RCYC is not requiring division flags for their event this weekend. This makes it easier for those boats just joining our fleet but it does mean that all boats should carry a copy of the IRC entry list as posted on the LORC website to identify who is sailing in the various divisions. John Crawley keeps this list updated on almost an hourly basis so be sure to download the information late Friday or early Saturday morning for the latest updates. This is a valuable resource and we thank John for his efforts to keep the information current and valuable for all IRC competitors.

For our IRC event this weekend at RCYC we will see an even larger fleet than sailed at ABYC and for the first time this season we will be joined by John Odenbach and his Rampage team from Rochester. All three IRC divisions will see new boats that have just recently been measured for IRC by our very busy measuring duo of John Crawley and Peter Wallace. We are well on our way to the goal of seventy-five boats measured for IRC in our region in 2010 with tremendous growth on Lake Ontario but a number of these newly rated boats from outside the Toronto area. We welcome new members Rob Butler and his Beneteau 10R from Collingwood, John Daniells and his Killing 50 from Midland, Joe Pawlowski and his Beneteau 10R from Youngstown and Andrew Reim and his J27 from Oakville. All our welcome additions to our steadily growing IRC fleet.

After this weekend our next IRC event is the PCYC Open Regatta which this year is our IRC Canadian Championship event. Be sure this is on your schedule as this is THE major event on our IRC regional racing schedule this year. We are expecting the largest IRC turnout of the season with boats from all around Lake Ontario and beyond in attendance. There will be our usual three IRC divisions and the possibility of an IRC0 fleet for our growing contingent of 'big boats'.
