Last week I was in Annapolis for the Sail America conference. This organization includes members of all parts of the sailing industry, from magazines to boatbuilders, sailmakers, hardware manufacturers, sailing schools, charter companies, you name it. Surprisingly there were not that many other dealers in attendance, and those who were not there missed out. The industry is on the road to recovery after a couple of very trying years, but all agreed things are improving.

The highlight of my trip was getting to sail "Yankee Zulu" in the Annapolis YC Wednesday night race. YZ is a Beneteau 10R belonging to my good friend Garth Hichens, owner of Annapolis Yacht Sales, and is the boat that won the PHRF National Championship at Key West in 2007. Garth said I was not good at anything else so I might as well drive. I guess he figured that the crew was so good (they were) that they could keep me out of trouble (they did).

What makes this series different from your typical club weeknight race is the finish location...right in front of the yacht club dock, with times taken off the upper deck. If you have ever attended the Annapolis SailBoat Show (who hasn't?) you will recall that there is very little sea room in front of the club since there are docks on both sides of the creek and of course a bridge across it. So the finish area is only open on one end. The finish line is only a couple of boatlengths from the bridge, so as soon as you cross the line you need to start the engine, drop sails, and make an abrupt left turn to get out of the way of the stream of boats finishing behind, less you run into the bridge. It is great

fun and they tell me there are few accidents, mainly because there are a lot of good sailors there. Anyway we had a great time and we ended up winning the race by 13 seconds.

It was the first time I had driven a 10R since we won Charleston Race Week a few years back, and it reminded me again of just what a fun to sail boat it is. Unfortunately it hit the market at the absolute wrong time, otherwise there would be twice as many of them sailing as there are now. But in this size range (33 feet) it is a terrific package.

Judging by the continued large turnouts for the LOSHRS events it is obvious that short-handed sailing is doing very well on Lake Ontario. In last weekend's races from Port Credit to Youngstown and back they had about 70 boats, sailing in various divisions of single- and double-handers with and without spinnakers.

The Lake Erie Interclub Cruise, variously referred to as the "Interclub", or "Erie Dover", begins this Saturday in Buffalo. The event normally starts in Erie, PA and ends in Buffalo. In recognition of Buffalo YC's 150th Anniversary this year the series has been reversed, starting at BYC and ending in Erie next week.

One of the better-known yachts on Lake Ontario, the Peterson 34 "Arrow", is now for sale. Owner Brook Richardson and crew have won many events over the last 30 years and the yacht has been regularly upgraded and well-maintained. See details in the For Sale section below.

**Congratulations to Meghan Jordan of the Buffalo YC** for earning All American Crew honors in collegiate sailing. Meghan just graduated from Hobart & William Smith which has become a power in college sailing.

**Hospice Regattas National Championship Report:** "Rochester NY - Skipper Kirsten Werner and her crew surpassed a competitive fleet of thirteen other teams, to win the 11th annual Hospice Regattas National Championship, held at the Rochester Yacht Club. All fourteen teams completed one round of

racing before severe weather on Sunday cut short the series. Most teams Saturday performed consistently during a second round of races that was not completed. Rules determined the final standings at the end of the last full round.

Werner complimented the Rochester Yacht Club, the race organizers, and the race committee, for "a spectacular job orchestrating the championship. Our team was honored to win this event supporting such an amazing cause." This was Ms. Werner's second time qualifying for the national championship, in which teams represent the 20-plus local hospice races held throughout the year to raise money and awareness for hospice care in their communities.

Werner's team has years of experience together on J24s and now a Beneteau 40.7. With her husband Kris on sail trim, Bobby Bryant on tactics, and Phil Hasl on the bow, the team finished first in five of the six races that determined the final results.

Placing a close second was Gary Tisdale and his team representing the regatta for Niagara County, held in Youngstown NY. Third was Bob McElwain and his crew from Naples, Florida.

Local regattas have netted over \$14 million in the 30 years since the first regatta. Most importantly, they have reached thousands of new people with information about hospice care.

This was the second of three years host Rochester Yacht Club, with an outstanding committee co-chaired by Hank Stuart, Mary Stuart, John Doyle, and Lauren Doyle, and their own crew of fellow sailors, local citizens, and Lifetime Care Hospice. ### **Ira Ross Great Race Match racing Series at Buffalo YC, by Timothy Hunt:**

With the Round Robin concluding on Saturday we moved to the Semi Finals to determine which two teams would advance to the Finals and which two would race in the Petit Finals.

In the Finals Van Tol Match Racing Team defeated Team Becker 2 - 0 and won the James H. Righter Trophy with a perfect score of 13 wins. Team Becker finished 2nd with 9 wins.

In the Petit Finals, Team ISV defeated team Swedish Bacon 2 - 0, finishing 3rd in the competition with a total of 11 wins, team Swedish Bacon finished 4th with 6 wins.

**11th Annual Oswego County Hospice Cup Regatta:** "Skipper Kirk Reynolds had "Mean Green" sailing like a machine on Saturday at the Oswego County Hospice Cup Regatta. The Skaneateles sailor led "Mean Green" to the championship of the regatta, held in Lake Ontario off Oswego Harbor.

The event, a fund-raiser for Oswego County Hospice patients and their families, was hosted by the Oswego International Marina and the Oswego Yacht Club.

"Mean Green," a J-24, took first-place overall in two of the regatta's three races, and was second overall in the other race. By winning the Oswego County Hospice Cup Regatta, Reynolds has qualified for the 2011 National Hospice Regattas Championship, to be held in Rochester.

Finishing second overall in the Oswego County Hospice Cup Regatta was "Oz," a J-24 skippered by Tom Doran of Oswego. In the three races, "Oz" placed first overall in one and second in the other two. Completing the top five in the overall standings were "Seaweed," a J-24 sailed by Charlie Krylo of the Oswego Yacht Club; "Peewee," a J-24 sailed by Kris Werner; and "Crusader," a J-30 skippered by Dan Mather of Oswego.

Twenty-five boats raced in the regatta. The overall Group 2 winner was "Puffin Plus," sailed by Don Clark of the Selkirk Yacht Club. "Puffin Plus" was the top Group 2 finisher in every race out of the six boats in the group.

Competition also took place within four divisions. "Crusader" placed first in Division 1. In the three races, "Crusader" finished first in the division in two of them, taking second in the other race. "Hiawatha," sailed by Bob Porter, took second in Division 1. "Moongator," skippered by Peter Quackenbush, was third.

In Division 2, the champion was "Splash," sailed by Ron Smith. Following were "Chaser," sailed by Fran Doyle; and "Judicious," sailed by Phil McBrearty. "Mean Green" won Division 3 over "Oz" and "Seaweed." The division consisted entirely of J-24s. "Puffin Plus" won Division 4. Completing the top three in the division were "Colorme," sailed by Mike Sorrell; and "Little Chickadee," sailed by Dick White."

On deck the boat is fitted with an anchor well for coastal cruising, a dedicated liferaft locker in the cockpit benches and a large storage locker with area for the stove gas bottle.

A 20HP Yanmar diesel with sail drive and folding propeller is also standard.

## Commentary:

**More fun anybody? by Don Finkle:** "Gary Jobson, among others, has recently written about bringing some fun and variety back into sailing. I happen to agree with this position entirely. There are numerous quality serious events for the hard core racer, but in fact there are likely more casual racers than hard core. So to encourage their continued and hopefully increased participation in racing we might try some more "fun" events. This also allows a boat to compete with fewer and/or less skilled crew, another way to grow new sailors. At our home club, Youngstown YC, we have a couple of these this week for example.

On Friday night we have a double-handed non-spinnaker short course race. The typical crew is husband-wife or father-son/daughter, etc. Young kids don't count against the "double-handed" limit. The course is set to last no more than an hour so everyone is back in time for dinner. Just a way to have another evening on the boat without the need to round up crew or mess with spinnakers. Every week more boats are showing up.

On Saturday YYC has their annual Secretary's Race. This event starts with the boats tied to the club dock and everyone inside at the bar. Then the Club Secretary signals the "start" and all crews run to their boats, cast off, and motor to the end of the mooring area. Once outside the area the motors are shut off and the race begins. Crews were drawn by name from a hat and so everyone is mixed up throughout the fleet, a good way to meet and sail with others. The finish is back at the club with the first boat to be tied up and the entire crew inside at the bar is declared the winner. There are any number of different ways to go racing other than the traditional round-the-cans stuff and we would be wise to mix it up on occasion to maintain interest."
