What's New? By Don Finkle: The LEIC finishes today with a race from Port Dover to Erie. They have had plenty of wind so far, including the race from Erie to Buffalo last Thursday which was a downwind screamer. Since then it has been mostly upwind. We will have results next week, and probably a story or two as well. BHSC does not run their regular weeknight races during the LEIC, which is a good means of avoiding conflict and forcing owners to choose between two competing events. Good on them.

This is a bit of a quiet week in most places. Here in Youngstown we have a lot going on though. Friday is a double-handed JAM race, and Saturday we have two dinghy events planned. One is the annual Laser regatta, the other is our Junior Sailing Alumni day. The latter consists of former juniors coming back to sail in the dinghies they learned on, with a dock party after. It is a really fun day that we always look forward to. If your club does not have something like this we encourage you to consider it.

There are only a few results this week, too busy to track them all down. Further, because most sites are run by volunteers, they are often not up to date and it takes a week or so before we can locate them.

RCR has passed the 100 boats sold mark for the current year. We mention this so those who are looking to make a boat change know that we can make it happen for you. This applies to buyers and sellers, give us a chance. Right now we need more boats to sell, and we have buyers ready to move.

Lake Ontario 300 Registration Deadline is TODAY June 30: With over 150 boats already registered, this year's race is going to be another exciting one. Registration deadline has been set to June 30 to ensure there is sufficient time to complete division splits, program the transponders and ensure adequate capacity for on-shore activities. If

We're trying something new this year and would invite you in the coming week to log on to our PCYC web regatta page at <http://pcyc.net/on-water-activities/regattas-at-pcyc/pcyc-open-regatta> to review all the Open Regatta information including completing and submitting an Open Regatta Visiting Yacht Registration Form on line well in advance of your arrival. We would then ask you to contact our PCYC Dock Office on VHF 68 upon your yachts arrival and follow their directions to the assigned mooring / rafting location. Once moored we request the skipper / owner confirm with the Dock Office in person. Please also note PCYC has limited parking on site and for those arriving by land we would ask for your cooperation in following the posted parking directions once on the property as well as the direction of our staff and volunteer parking attendants. Please do not park in the designated Fire Routes as your vehicle will be ticketed and towed by the police. We very much appreciate your cooperation by parking in the designated areas.
 Thank you and welcome to Port Credit Yacht Club.

Congratulations to 5 of the EYCRF sailors. "Aaron Ackerman, John Garhart, Jeff Benson, Tom Cross, and Al Belovarac completed 100 mile / 24 hour solo sails over the last two weekends. They persevered through a variety of difficult conditions to complete the required distance and time requirements. This sail qualifies each of them to apply for entry into one of the GLSS Challenges. The GLSS currently runs a solo challenge on each of the Great Lakes. We hope to see one or all of them at the starting line for the 271 nautical mile 2010 Lake Erie Solo Challenge at the end of August. Again, congratulations on such a terrific personal accomplishment."

Commentary:

A Local Dilemma, by Don Finkle: "I qualified by saying this is a "local" dilemma, because the problem exists mainly at the club level. At major regattas those in attendance are generally well-crewed, well-prepared and experienced. Therefore the competitive level within the fleet is more balanced. But what about the typical club level race? Often there is a wide gap between the top and bottom of the fleet. There are those who have been sailing all their lives, take it very seriously, have a good crew, sails and equipment and as a result they perform at a high level, even on a Wednesday night race. At the other end there is the beginner in an old slow boat who is hopelessly outclassed. Due to the limited number of boats competing at most clubs, especially the smaller ones, these folks end up racing together. Often there is not much joy at either end, not enough competition for the better sailors, and the lesser ones get smoked.

The problem is more easily identified than solved. You don't want the better sailors to dumb-down what they love to do, or get rid of the excellent crew they enjoy sailing with. The newer sailor will take time to learn the game, and he/she will find it hard to grab the best crew until they raise their level of competence. So the wide gap remains, and the worry is that the folks who are not seeing any satisfaction in the results may not stick it out long enough to get better. After all, those at the top rarely get worse.

Other sports deal with this by means of handicapping the people, not the equipment, where in our sport we handicap the equipment. I know we've written about this before, but the problem still remains and we would like to see some more ideas put forth on creating a better way."
