The J/24 Worlds are coming to Rochester YC in 2012: Kris Werner and Lambert Lai submitted the winning bid for RYC to host the 2012 J/24 Worlds. Tentative dates are September 15-21, 2012. More info to follow!

Beneteau First 35 named "Yacht of the Year" by Voile Magazine: A panel of Voile Magazine journalists, a group of specialists in sailing, and a selection of Voile Magazine readers noted that the main reason that the First 35 won the award was the fact that the boat achieved its primary design brief of having the superior blend of a dual purpose program offering true cruising capability while also providing exciting racing performance. The magazine cited several important characteristics of this new model, including the following:

- High precision and control of the helm
- A yacht that is easy to sail with a manageable sail plan
- A yacht with a strong personality
- A pleasing and flattering modern profile
- A comfortable and inviting interior layout

The Beneteau First 35 is imported by Beneteau USA for the American market

J/Boats is working on their latest model, the J/111: Their first new 35 footer in 8 years (J/109 was introduced in 2001). Stu Johnstone explains why the timing of this new boat makes so much sense:

"If you remember, in difficult economic times, like the early 80s, we came out with the J/29 and the J/35 - both derivatives of earlier boats - the J/30 and the J/36. In the early 90s, we came out with the J/105 during a recession. Needless to say, a good solid mid-30's size boat does well, particularly when an economy comes out of a severe recession. The J/111 is getting back to our basics, great performance for the dollar.

"What's interesting is that we've had a few dozen of our owners wishfully looking for a 'next gen' modern J/Boat in the same size category. The J/111 incorporates a proven large daysailing cockpit with a big wheel, tall high-aspect ratio rig with non-overlapping headsails, high-aspect bulb keel, planing hull shape, and a 6-foot standing headroom/ weekending interior. In other words, it builds on a combination of qualities that have made the J/109, J/105, J/35 and J/36 successful - we expect the J/111 to be a fun, fast, easy to handle boat with extraordinary performance.
