**What's New? By Don Finkle:** Reminder that there is an Ullman-Obersheimer sailing seminar tonight in Buffalo at Charlie's, 1884 Niagara St., 7:15 TO 9:30 PM.

We got the word today that our Farr 11S has finally been released for pick-up from the dock in NJ where it has been tied up for almost 3 weeks waiting for Customs to inspect it. Talk about Government efficiency! It should be in Buffalo by the weekend and then next week we'll rig it and make sure it all fits together.

Yesterday I was looking at our sales figures for Oct-Nov of 2009 versus the same period last year. For those two months a year ago we sold only one race boat, this year we sold six. This is good news for one of the market segments most affected by the economic turbulence. We are working with a number of other racing clients who are interested in a boat change for 2010. Sailors normally don't quit sailing when times are slow, but they may postpone their plans. We can feel the pent-up demand as people recognize the deals to be had right now.

**THE RACING RULES OF SAILING FOR 2009 - 2012:** As a result of actions taken by the ISAF Racing Rules Committee and the ISAF Council during the ISAF Annual Conference, several changes in The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009-2012 will take effect on 1 January 2010. The changes are shown in detail below. (thanks to Hank Stuart for this info)

Rule 18.2(c):

(c) When a boat is required to give mark-room by rule 18.2(b), she shall continue to do so even if later an overlap is broken or a new overlap begins. However, if the boat entitled to mark-room passes head to wind or leaves the zone, rule 18.2(b) ceases to apply.

Definition Obstruction:

Obstruction An object that a boat could not pass without changing course substantially, if she were sailing directly towards it and one of her hull lengths from it. An object that can be safely passed on only one side and an area so designated by the sailing instructions are also obstructions. However, a boat racing is not an obstruction to other boats unless they are required to keep clear of her or, if rule 22 applies, avoid her. A vessel under way, including a boat racing, is never a continuing obstruction.

Definition Party:

Party A party to a hearing: a protestor; a protestee; a boat requesting redress or for which redress is requested by the race committee or considered by the protest committee under rule 60.3(b); a race committee acting under rule 60.2(b); a boat or competitor that may be penalized under rule 69.1; a race committee or organizing authority in a hearing under rule 62.1(a).

Appendix B, Rule B3.1(c):

Rule 18.2(c) is changed to:

When a board is required to give mark-room by rule 18.2(b), she shall continue to do so even if later an overlap is broken or a new overlap begins. However, if the board entitled to mark-room passes head to wind rule 18.2(b) ceases to apply.

Appendix C, Rule C2.12 (a new rule):

C2.12 Rule 18.2(e) is changed to 'If a boat obtained an inside overlap and from the time the overlap began, the outside boat has been unable to give markroom, she is not required to give it.'

Appendix J

J1.2 The notice of race shall include any of the following that will apply and that would help competitors decide whether to attend the event or that

conveys other information they will need before the sailing instructions become available:

(2) that competitor advertising will be restricted or that boats will be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority (see ISAF Regulation 20) and other information related to Regulation 20;
