**The new Farr 11S** we sold to a Buffalo client has finally arrived and the canting keel and twin rudders have been installed by our staff. Later this week Peter Eagan of Hall Spars, who built the spars and rig package, will come to Buffalo to assist us in assembling this custom rig. A project like this is not at all like doing a production boat. We started two years ago, working with Bill O'Malley at Farr YS. Our boat is hull #5, and continual modifications and improvements have been made since the first boat went sailing. The project not only involved Bill, but also the designers at Farr Yacht Design, the builders at Premier Composites in Dubai, Hall Spars and rigging for all standing and running rigging, the owner's expertise in designing a better hydraulic system for the canting keel, Ockam Instruments, North Sails, and RCR as coordinator of the whole package. My file on this boat is already over 2 inches thick and there is a lot

left to do before we go sailing. It has been a worthwhile exercise, not only for the challenge of a custom project like this, but also for all that we have learned along the way. Wait until people see this rocket on the water next spring!

**We are selling more boats of late**, there is more activity and the pent-up demand is resulting in much better sales than last year at this time. It is also encouraging that race boats are selling once more, that was a very disappointing segment of the market last year. Yacht World, the largest on-line used boat marketplace, sends us monthly reports of the number of boats being sold and the price trends for their entire system. Beginning this summer the downward trends in both unit sales and selling prices started to reverse themselves and the industry is now seeing more sales volume and a stop to the bottoming out of prices. Those waiting for the deals to get better should think again, because as the market is improving the selection will diminish.

**We hope you all had a wonderful Thanksgiving.** Heather and I visited our kids and their families in Newport, RI for the holiday. Naturally I was able to sneak off to do some prowling of the local boatyards. I had planned on inspecting a brokerage boat for one of our clients while there, to see if it was worth his effort to make the trip later to see it. Unfortunately it was not. We would like to share a few observations with you:

The boat I went to see looked good on paper and in the few photos provided by the listing broker. I have found that most of the small photos posted on the Internet typically make any boat look better than it really is. This is because they are not close-ups and don't show the "warts". For a 12 year old boat of this considerable value I was surprised at how the owner had let the condition deteriorate. I was also surprised at how little effort (virtually none) had been spent to prepare the boat to show. In the salon there was a bucket sitting on the seat to catch water from a hatch leak, and there was considerable water in it! We are talking about a \$150K boat here. Note to sellers: any money and time spent to prepare your boat for sale will be readily repaid in a better price and a quicker sale. There are too many options for buyers, they don't want to buy your problems and clean up your mess.

Those of us who spend most of our time on fresh water don't realize just how much salt water effects the condition and aging of a boat. Even with good maintenance the salt water and air ages a boat and all of its systems much more rapidly. Take that into consideration when you see the prices of salt water boats advertised. A fresh water boat will always be more valuable, everything else being equal.
