Regular readers will note that we skipped last week, one of those rare occasions where we did not have time to send out this newsletter.

We would like to remind you that the Beneteau Invest in America Sale ends next week, May 15. If you are looking for a super value on a terrific new boat now is the time. The sale date will not be extended. Last week we delivered three new Beneteaus to their

proud owners, a 36.7 and two 10R's. You could be next.

Hunter Marine also has a sale running right now, with Free Options, depending on model and some other factors. Any way you slice it the deal is very attractive.

Some of our friends are enjoying the cruising life as this is being written. One family is bringing the boat they bought from us back from Newport, RI on her own bottom. They phoned me yesterday to say they were in the NY State Barge Canal on their way to Oswego, and eventually to their home port here in Youngstown. The dad thought it would be a good bonding experience to do the trip with wife and two sons, and he said it has been super so far. Hank and Ann have been cruising their 42 foot trawler through the Bahamas, and just returned to Florida for haul-out and some maintenance work before starting to head back north. They will be in New England this summer and we look forward to meeting up with them at some point.

We are finding it is not generally known that the sale of used boats works a lot like multiple listings in real estate. Those of us who broker boats for sale share listings between us, and often one broker has a buyer looking for a particular boat and another broker somewhere else has the boat we are looking for. The commission does not change, the brokers just share it, so there is no financial impact on buyer or seller. RCR is doing more co-brokerage deals than ever before, as we match buyers and sellers, regardless of location. Keep in mind that the boats we have listed are only a small fraction of the boats we have available for sale through the networks. If you are looking to buy a boat please see us first and we'll find it for you. This is much better than buying a boat from someone far away who you don't know and who you will likely never see again.

We imagine that most of you subscribe to at least one sailing magazine, and you've no doubt noticed, as we have, that these publications are a lot thinner (fewer pages) than they used to be. The Internet is fine but we would hate to see the loss of any more marine publications, there is something nice about being able to hold it in your hand and take with you. We would like to bring to your attention the three Canadian magazines that we advertise in, because they each have news and stories that are relevant to those of us who sail on the Great Lakes. The big boys write about far off destinations, but the Canadian mags also have stories about destinations and action much closer to home. Check out GAM, Canadian Yachting and Ontario Sailor to see what we mean.

There is a not-for-profit organization in Buffalo named Buffalo Niagara Riverkeeper that is dedicated to the preservation, remediation and improvement of our waterways. They have a small powerboat that will be used for patrol, testing and other duties. RCR is providing them with a dock in our Buffalo marina. The boat is as yet unnamed but you may see it this summer.

May 22, First Mate Safe Return class at the Sodus Point Fire Department from

0900 to 1300 hrs. As a First Mate aboard your boat, just how familiar are you with its operation? What if the Skipper should become disabled? Would you know what to do? Would you know how to call for help? Would you be able to tell rescuers where you are? Would you be able to navigate to a safe port?

The First Mate Safe Return course is designed to teach fundamental skills that will enable a First Mate to do the right thing if the Skipper should become disabled for whatever reason. The course will be taught by Coast Guard Licensed Captains and will include a half-day classroom lecture and on-the-water coaching and demonstration on your own boat. The schedule for the half-day classroom lecture is:

Time: 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM

The on-the-water coaching and demonstration may be arranged at the mutual convenience of the First Mate and a Captain Instructor from SBMCA, or at the option of the student, may be conducted by the student's skipper.
