**What's New? by Don Finkle:** We have been running around like crazy since the first of April, but the three busiest weeks of our year are this week and the next two. Oh, the joys of a seasonal business! Being sailors ourselves we understand the anxious excitement that accompanies the start of a new season, and this is especially true if you have a new boat.

Sometimes during the long off season we tend to forget just how much fun it is to be out on the water again. Last Saturday and Sunday I got out briefly each day, checking out customers on their new boats. When the sails filled and the boat started to move it all came rushing back to me; yeah, this is what it is all about! There is no other feeling quite like it.

There has been no shortage of news about problems within the banking industry and the effects this has had on businesses and consumers. For sure things have been different for us the last couple of years as a result of the changes in lending practices. Actually the credit crunch has been harder on builders and dealers than it has been on retail customers. Dealers found it very much more difficult to borrow money for stock inventory boats, and this made it even harder for the builders who could not ship boats that dealers could not afford to take. To make matters worse, a number of lenders who were in the business of loaning money to dealers for stock boats (known as floorplan) either exited the business or cut way back on what they would lend. In many areas of the Country this resulted in closures of dealerships and boatbuilders, most of which sold powerboats. In our more conservative part of the World here on the Great Lakes we weren't the ones guilty of high-flying, but we all got dragged down by some of the excesses in Florida, Texas and California.

On the positive side, things are starting to loosen up again. Inventory of boats at dealerships and at boatbuilders are way down from previous levels. Those guilty of excesses have been weeded out. As is often the case, when something bad happens

the "solution" often overshoots the mark in attempting to fix the problem, and that is what the banks did, tightened up more than they needed to. They did cause all of us a lot of pain, but the situation has improved.

What about customers who want to get a boat loan? The banks did get very tight almost overnight when things went south two years ago, but they have since realized that they were at first too lenient, then too tight, and are now getting back to reasonable lending practices. We have had no trouble getting financing for our customers who have good credit scores. Assuming that one has good credit, the major obstacle for us now is the age of the boat. We all know that a fiberglass boat that is well made and has been well maintained has a long useful life. Banks don't see it the same way though, they are becoming much fussier about loaning on older boats. This is where sailboats have been dragged down by powerboats, the latter depreciating more rapidly and the lenders don't seem to want to differentiate between sail and power...we've tried to no avail. But because we have access to a variety of lenders we can usually find a way to finance most boats and most buyers. Probably the trend that we have seen grow the most during this period is the use of home equity lines to buy boats with. Maybe as many as a third of the boats we sell are financed in this manner.

The bottom line is this: the worst is behind us and if you are looking to buy a boat we can usually find a way for you to finance it.

We need to do a better job of getting the word out, so it needs to be repeated. RCR finds boats for people, regardless of whether we have them here locally or not. Examples of boats that we have found out of town for our customers this winter include a Beneteau First 36.7, Shock 35, Sabre 386TR, and a C&C 38-3. So please understand that just because you don't see what you are looking for on our website doesn't mean we can't get it for you. *And it does not cost you any more money to do this, the price you pay is the same.* So when you are ready to look for another boat, please give us a call. The same goes for selling, we have found buyers for our customers' boats from all over.

**May 22, First Mate Safe Return class** at the Sodus Point Fire Department from 0900 to 1300 hrs. As a First Mate aboard your boat, just how familiar are you with its operation? What if the Skipper should become disabled? Would you know what to do? Would you know how to call for help? Would you be able to tell rescuers where you are? Would you be able to navigate to a safe port?

The First Mate Safe Return course is designed to teach fundamental skills that will enable a First Mate to do the right thing if the Skipper should become disabled for whatever reason. The course will be taught by Coast Guard Licensed Captains and will include a half-day classroom lecture and on-the-water coaching and demonstration on your own boat. The schedule for the half-day classroom lecture is:
