**What's New? by Don Finkle:** Last evening we saw the fruits of two year's worth of effort come together. Dick Aubrecht wanted to take our Buffalo service staff out for a ride on his new 36 foot Farr 11S raceboat. We had the boat custom built for Dick in Dubai, and given the complexity of the project it has been a long time between first concept and going sailing. There have been no shortage of teething problems, and Dick wanted to reward our guys who helped by taking us out for a ride and letting us experience first-hand what this boat is really like under sail. We were rewarded with an exhilarating ride in a 20 knot breeze on a beautiful warm evening.

I don't think it would be an exaggeration to liken the Farr 11S to a Formula One race car. To give you some idea of what we are talking about: the boat is all carbon fiber construction, hull, deck, mast, boom, bowsprit, keel, rudders, etc. This makes it super light weight, less than half what many other boats this length might weigh. Even the sink below is carbon! But "below" isn't much to talk about, the headroom is less than 5 feet. This boat is all about sailing, nothing more. The keel cants hydraulically from one side to another, so the stability is tremendous when you get it swung all the way over to windward. Because the keel is canted it does not offer much lateral surface when going upwind, so there are twin retractable daggerboards to keep the boat from slipping sideways. They are airfoil shaped and set at an angle so they actually help lift the boat to weather.

There are twin rudders too, linked to a centerline tiller. Each rudder is very small, but they are also set at an angle so when the boat heels they become vertical. I stood at the back of the cockpit and watched the water go by the rudders and marveled at how effective they were despite their small size. Dick let me drive for a bit and the control was superb. The mast is controlled by twin running backstays and a jack at the base. The small diesel engine has a shaft and prop that retracts into the bottom of the boat when sailing. The spinnaker is a gigantic masthead sail set from a long retractable carbon bowsprit, the headsails are fractional, and the mainsail is a very large square-top

design. There is no deckhouse, the freeboard is low, and the cockpit is extra long and really comfortable. All in all it is something very special.

Dick is a prince of a guy and has been nothing short of wonderful to work with during this long project. Being a design engineer by profession, he understands that when you are dealing with new technology you will always have hurdles to get over. But the reward of that new technology is a leap forward from what you had before. I have never gone as fast on a monohull as we went last night, and the boat felt rock-steady. There were big grins all around. Thanks Dick!

We service a lot of boats, not only those we sell but those who store, moor and/or dock with us at our two yards in Buffalo and Youngstown. This summer we've had a number of boats that needed work and our guys have done a super job at tackling some tough problems. So our hat is off to the service staff of Bruce, John H, Bob, Darren, Andy, Mike, Brian, Billy, Chris A, John T, Chris G, and newcomers Rex and Kenny.

**Cruising notes from Maine:** Hank Evans sends me frequent e-mails so we can keep track of his travels, with wife Ann, aboard their 42 foot trawler. Right now they are in Maine. Here are a few excerpts from recent e-mails:

"I just can't believe all the schooners in Maine. Dozens and dozens in the 60-90' range and quite a few 90 to 150+. They seem to be everywhere and are just breathtaking to see under full sail. Good thing the season here is only about 5 months or the rest of the country would want to live here."

"We came upon a brochure for the Maine Windjammers. Believe it or not, windjammers was once a derogatory term for sailing vessels that the steam powered boat people used for the old sailing ships. It lists 12 schooners that date back as far as 1871 that ply the Maine coast for charter and sail training during the summers. Between our two day stay at Rockland and arrival today in Camden, we have seen all 12 of them. Sitting at mooring this morning in Rockland the Stephen Tabor sailed by. Built in 1871, she is the oldest boat in continuous service in the US. That is a pretty impressive history."

"Moored to a CYC float, we are within 100 yards of downtown and the array of boats is truly impressive. White Hawk is here along with many impressive old sailing yachts, 9 large schooners and several Mega yachts. We are at the end of the harbor where all the boats come through and turn to go back out. Kinda like being at the end of ego alley just larger. Just an impressive place. Wish you were here to enjoy with us and tell me what half these boats are.

In response to my question to him about the perceived difficulties of cruising in Maine: "You get used to 10' tides and everything is floating docks so you really aren't that concerned or bothered by it. We've found the navigation to be no more difficult than most other areas. Channels are well marked. A lot easier than say the New Jersey ICW which is poorly marked, confusing and shallow. Not to mention the country's most inconsiderate and obnoxious boaters ! At least here you have deep water. We've lost only one day to fog, so far, although they are having a good summer here as opposed to last which was terrible. (as it was in the North Channel for us). No doubt, the water is too cold to enjoy swimming. Lobster pots are a pain and

everywhere, but you even get used to those. Worse than the crab pots down south, but at least the buoys are twice the size and much easier to spot in choppy waters. All in all, definitely worth the trip."

**From another cruiser coming home from the Upper Lakes:** "Don, Yes, the cruise has exceeded all expectations. The North Shore of Lake Superior is one of the finest and most challenging cruising grounds LaVida has seen. Words just can't express the wild beauty that exists there. When I get home I'll post some photos of the trip (only took 6,457 so far :-). Currently in Cheyboygan, MI and leaving for Olcott tomorrow morning. Hope to be home in three to four weeks. Sea u, Mike"

**Hunter marine is now on Facebook.** I'm not a Facebook person, so don't ask me any of the details, but if you are then check it out.

**The New Hunter 36 footer will be known and the e36.** The e stands for the extended swim platform. It will have a transom swim platform that raises and lowers. We are very anxious to see this latest model as the 36 foot size range has always been very popular in our area and Hunter does a wonderful job with their cruising boats. Look for the new Hunter 50 this fall too. Other models in the Hunter family include the 27, 31, 33, 39, 41DS, 45DS, 45CC and 50CC.
