### **GET YOUR U.S.C.G. CAPTAIN'S LICENSE:**

If you have ever thought about getting that license, now is your chance. Sodus Bay Maritime Captains Association, a not-for-profit membership organization, has arranged with Sea Tech Marine Training to conduct courses leading to a U.S. Coast Guard Captain's License. Sea Tech Marine is a U.S. Coast Guard approved training school that is authorized to give the license exam locally. That is, you won't have to travel to Toledo, Ohio.

The course this winter will be held at the Hampton Inn North, 500 Center Place, Rochester, NY. The class schedule for fall 2009 is as follows:

Saturday, October 24 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

**RCR Yachts of Erie News by Tracy Buczak: More haulouts...good sales activity and for the most part decent weather. Opps...I spoke too soon.**

Brian has been here the last few days winterizing. Good to see him again and share some food and conversation.

I was asked to repeat a piece about tanks and liquids published a couple of years ago. Here it is:

**Helpful Hints: from time to time I hear some interesting stories about filling tanks aboard with other than they were designed for liquids.** One story I heard earlier this year was the 393 owner who filled his

holding tanks with water instead of his water tanks...Embarrassing, but harmless. How about putting diesel in a water tank? Yuk. Solution? Don't let the contamination get into the vinyl tubing or it will be ruined. Isolate the tank. I have heard many remedies from using **Dawn** dishwashing liquid to emulsify the diesel then pump it out and rinse the tank. Or, Mix one 8-ounce bottle of hydrogen peroxide, 2- tablespoons of baking soda, a quarter cup of dish soap and one gallon of water. Wash your tank out with this and then rinse it. You may have to flush it a few times and may want to finish with bleach and water. Or, Use Star Brite Aqua Clean following the directions on the container. This product contains non-toxic cleaners and emulsifiers that will remove all traces of the diesel fuel and any other contaminants from fresh water tanks.

But the most creative solution I heard was...**cheap Vodka**, and lots of it!

The key, as a chemist pointed out to me, is to find a solvent that is compatible with both diesel and water. His choice is anhydrous (i.e. a 100% solution with no water added) isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol, although in this form it generally has water added). It can be bought at an industrial solvent shop. If anhydrous cannot be found, get the highest concentration possible, and not less than 70%, should be used.

After the tank has been drained it should be flushed with the alcohol to remove any pooled diesel at the bottom of the tank. It would be best to isolate any pumps and valves when doing this-the concentrated alcohol may cause rubber parts to swell. Next, partially fill the tank with water, add alcohol, and fill it all the way to the top to flush the sides and top of the tank. The alcohol/diesel solution pumped from the tank should be recovered and disposed of properly.

**Vodka is approximately 40% ethanol**, which is chemically close to isopropyl alcohol. My chemist tells me it is not as effective a solvent for diesel as isopropyl alcohol, but assures me it works, but requires "lots". In any case, with enough Vodka in the tank, who is going to care about any remaining diesel?

I have heard of adding vodka after draining a tank for the season to keep unwanted organisms from growing and the vodka doesn't freeze of course.
