NY REQUIRES LIFE JACKETS FOR COLD WEATHER BOATERS Starting Nov. 1, kayakers, canoeists and those aboard all other boats under 21 feet must wear Coast Guard-approved personal flotation devices while on New York's coastal waters, lakes, rivers and other waterways. The rule will remain in effect through May 1. Violators face fines ranging from \$25 to \$100.

GET YOUR U.S.C.G. CAPTAIN'S LICENSE:

If you have ever thought about getting that license, now is your chance. Sodus Bay Maritime Captains Association, a not-for-profit membership organization, has arranged with Sea Tech Marine Training to conduct courses leading to a U.S. Coast Guard Captain's License. Sea Tech Marine is a U.S. Coast Guard approved training school that is authorized to give the license exam locally. That is, you won't have to travel to Toledo, Ohio.

The course this winter will be held at the Hampton Inn North, 500 Center Place, Rochester, NY. The class schedule for fall 2009 is as follows:

Saturday, October 24 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 Sunday, October 25 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 Saturday, October 31 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 Sunday, November 1 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

The price for the basic (OUPV or "Six-Pack") course is \$695. If you elect to step up to a Master's License (as most participants do), there are three additional class sessions, an additional exam and an additional fee of \$200.

Maintenance tip: Marine Batteries should be topped up with distilled water & fully charged. If they are not being charged via a solar panel or charger with float regulation, remove them from the boat and store in a cool dry place. If in a basement or garage do not place directly on concrete floors but on wood blocks above the floor. Bring the batteries to a full charge once a month. Clean the terminals before storage. Cover the terminal for safety. It's all right to leave them on the boat fully charged and wouldn't hurt to charge them a

couple of times thru the winter.

Now is a good time to get your sails conditioned or repaired before the crunch of next season.

Hey guys, would it be nice to surprise her with a new boat you bought for you...I mean her under the tree?

How Shopping for a Used Boat Works, by Don Finkle: There are basically two ways to search for and purchase a used boat. The first method is to shop all over until you find something you like and buy it from whoever has it. This process means working with a lot of people and businesses who you either don't know or who are not local to where you sail or live. You might find a boat you like this way, but you might not be dealing with the best outfit, or the company best positioned to take care of your needs, as opposed to the seller they represent. We find folks who get drawn into a purchase this way because they shop on the Internet and end up buying from XYZ Yachts in Timbuktu. After the fact they learn that they could have purchased the same boat from their local broker and gotten more help and advice during the process.

The Internet has made it easier to find boats, but it often leads customers to assume that all of the other aspects of a boat purchase are just as easy...but they are not. You still need advice along the way, help with writing the proper offer, negotiations, survey, financing, shipping, insurance, trucking, delivery, etc.

There is a better way. You can have your cake and eat it too, how often do you get an offer like that? Because any good broker cooperates with other bona fide brokers and dealers, you can use your local broker to purchase that very same boat, and for the same price...maybe even less with his/her help. It works like this. Good brokers use what is called a Central Listing, which means that the boats they have for sale are available to other brokers on an MLS basis. You select the broker who you feel most comfortable with and let him/her represent you in your search, negotiations, and delivery.

Once you have an understanding with your own broker the two of you work together to find the right boat. It doesn't matter where that boat is, your broker will work with the broker who has the boat and they share the commission. It does not cost the seller or the buyer any more to do this, because the commission the seller pays is just shared, not increased. So we suggest that you pick a good broker who you trust and whose advice you value and let them work for you. Obviously we would rather keep half a loaf as opposed to seeing all of the commission go to someone far away who isn't a part of the local boating community like RCR is. Contact any of our brokers and they will be happy to explain this further and answer your questions.

Thanks Don, I think I can speak for all my fellow brokers when I say we all love to work with clients, build relationships and do all we can to find the right fit for customer and boat. Relationship building is one of the nicest parts of working in this business. Customers enjoy their recreation and RCR and I get some new friends. It is like a family.

Here is another of the responses I got with the Boat name piece:

"When we bought a wonderful Islander 28 we debated on what to name it. Because of my interest in bagpiping, our daughter suggested we call it "Piper's Due". The "due" is the shot of Single Malt a piper receives for his services. After fifteen years we moved up to a Morgan 38 which RCR helped us obtain and so we elected to keep the old name but added a "II" so we now sail "Piper's Due II." Both the name and the boat attract attention!"

Pumpkin Cheesecake

Adapted from the Stuffed Mushroom Restaurant, Buffalo, NY

2½ cups crushed vanilla wafers

1 tsp cinnamon

1 cup sour cream

½ cups butter, melted

½ tsp nutmeg

1 tsp vanilla

1 cup pumpkin

½ tsp ginger

2 Tbsp sugar

2-8 oz packages cream cheese

1½ tsp vanilla

2/3 cup sugar

3 tsp flour

4 eggs

Preheat oven to 350°.

In medium bowl, combine wafer crumbs and butter. Press mixture firmly onto bottom of 8-9" round spring-form pan. In mixer bowl, beat together cream cheese and sugar until fluffy. Add eggs, pumpkin, spices, 1½ teaspoon vanilla and flour and mix until thoroughly combined. Pour into prepared crust and bake 40-45 minutes until firm/cooked through. Combine sour cream, 1 teaspoon vanilla, and 2 tablespoons sugar and spread evenly over cream cheese layer. Return to oven for 15 minutes. Cool then chill thoroughly.
