

Sponsorship / Charitable Donation Policy & Procedure

Red River Harley Davidson appreciates your involvement to help our communities be better places in which to live and work. Because we are “Harley-Davidson”, we receive as many as 30 requests per month for sponsorship and donations to worthwhile projects and causes. Because of the volume of request we had to find a fair and equitable means to participate with these events. Anything beyond what is outlined in this memo is not an option for us. So, please don't embarrass us or yourself by asking for your event to be an exception to what we are able to do. Keep in mind, we cannot give the “door keys of the store” to every good cause and stay in business.

Each Saturday from April through October we furnish all the equipment and food stuffs for organizations to cook and serve hot dogs or hamburgers on the East side of store.

The charitable organization is responsible for securing necessary health permit(s) from the Wichita County Health Department, providing the man power assist our staff in setting up the site, cooking and serving. Set up usually takes 30 minutes and begins at 10:30 AM. Serving time is from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Your organization can put up any publically appropriate display to advertise their cause and a “Donation” container. Bake sale and other sellable goods are acceptable as well. We noticed those charities that advertise on TV, radio and in print do better than simply by ‘word of mouth’. Some organizations have raised as much as \$1,000 in two hours.

To schedule an event, call 940.264.7743 and ask for Amber. She will let you know what dates are available for your organization. This is on a first come first serve basis. Organizations are limited to no more than two events until the first of July; after that time, any open dates will be offered to whoever wants to hold additional events. Rain dates will be allowed IF there is a vacant date available.
