

Buck's Lake/Lake Almanor

Description

You decide if you want to visit one or both lakes. Located near the Lassen Volcanic National Park this ride offers very scenic views of the forest. If you visit Lassen, all four types of volcanoes in the world are found in the park, over 150 miles of trails and a culturally significant scenic highway provide access to volcanic wonders including steam vents, mudpots, boiling pools, volcanic peaks, and painted dunes. Buck's Lake and Lake Almanor offer great fishing and relaxing environment.

Turn left out of the Rider's Convenience Center. Turn right onto Harvard. Turn left onto Market and make an immediate right onto Louise. Turn right onto Mill Street and follow the signs to the onramp of 395 (North). Follow Highway 395 across the California Stateline and on to Susanville. Once in Susanville take Highway 36 west through Westwood, Hamilton Branch and Chester. Take Highway 89 South to Lake Almanor and/or continue on 89 to Quincy. In Quincy take Highway 162 to Buck's Lake. To return, either reverse the directions and go the same way you came or continue on the 70 to Highway 99. Take Highway 99 toward Marysville. Take Highway 20 through Grass Valley and Nevada City. The 20 will connect to Highway 80. Take Highway 80 East to Reno. Once in Reno take the 395 South exit and head toward Carson City. Take the Mill Street exit. Turn right onto Mill Street and immediately get into the left lane. Turn left on Louise and take an immediate left onto Market. Follow Market around to the Reno Harley-Davidson/Buell dealership and back to the Rider's Convenience Center.
