BMW Maintenance Schedule

The proper care and service of your new BMW is essential to its safe dependable operation, longevity and to the protection of your investment. We recommend that you place all the service needs of your BMW in the hands of your BMW motorcycle center. We have made a substantial investment in Service Training, Special Tools, Diagnostic Equipment, & Original BMW Parts. Our Certified Technicians perform high quality repairs in a minimum of time.

The effort you make to provide regularly scheduled maintenance, consistent annual servicing and proper care for the finish of your motorcycle, will reward you with years of safe and reliable enjoyment.

Maintenance work is divided into Service, Inspection, and Annual Service.

Please refer to your maintenance schedule for complete details, the information below is only a brief summary

Service – Mileage Related *First Service Required at 600 Miles

Level I

After the first 6,000 miles then every additional 12,000 miles

- 6,000 miles
- 18,000 miles
- 30,000 miles
- 42,000 miles...etc.
- Includes: Valve Adjust all twins & non K4X, (K4X every 24k), Throttle Body or Carb Sync as needed, Full inspection (hoses, cables, tires, tire pressure, brakes, lights, signals), LOF, Bleed Test (ABS), Test Ride and our own 30 point inspection.
- **Combine with recommended Annual based on time**

Inspection – Mileage Related Major Service – Please Don't Skip!

Level II

After the first 12,000 miles then every additional 12,000 miles

- 12,000 miles – Level I plus spark plugs, and transmission fluid change
- 24,000 miles – Level I plus spark plugs, fuel filter, sometimes a belt (on Twins), and final drive and transmission fluid change.
- 36,000 miles – Same as 12K
- 48,000 miles – Same as 24K
- **Combine with recommended Annual based on time**

Annual Service – Time Related

Annual 1, 2 or 4 yrs

Certain items of maintenance work depend on elapsed time as well as the distance the motorcycle has been driven. They should therefore be performed at least once a year (e.g. replacing the brake fluid). If these items cannot be performed during a Service or an Inspection, then an Annual Service is strongly recommended

- **Brake flush recommended every 2 & 4 years**
- **Clutch Fluid recommended every 4 years**
- **Coolant flush recommended every 4 years**

The following items are NOT COVERED under your BMW Warranty: Scheduled maintenance items & services such as oil changes, wheel balancing, lubrications, poly V-belt adjustments, chain or drive belt adjustments, steering head bearing adjustments, and throttle body synchronization. Service & Wear items such as brake pads, linings and rotor assemblies, clutch plates, bulbs, fuses, control cables, hand grips, chain and sprockets. Also, aftermarket installed items that affect factory installed components may not be covered. Please see your owners-warranty manual for complete details.

Important Care and Safety Information

- For your own safety, use only genuine BMW spare parts and accessories approved by BMW.
- Your BMW Rider's Manual will provide information on Operation Instructions, Safety and Riding hints.
- General Specifications, as well as additional care and maintenance procedures with intervals for your motorcycle are found in the Service and Technical booklet.
- The finish of your motorcycle will be enhanced by regular washing with approved cleaning products. Avoid high pressure washing systems, and touch up any stone chip damage immediately.
- We strongly recommend that your motorcycle remain covered when not in use.
- Safe operation of the disc brake system on your motorcycle will be realized by following BMW's recommendation to **change brake fluid annually** regardless of mileage.
- When your motorcycle is not in regular use, take the proper steps for storage of your motorcycle and care of your battery.
